To ensure the best chance of getting the courses you select, it is important that you use the following guidelines:

- ✓ Students that will be in grade 10 and 11 must choose 8 credits.
- ✓ Students that will be in Grade 12 must choose at least 7 credits
- ✓ When selecting your courses make sure you are fulfilling your Compulsory credits.
- ✓ When selecting your courses you must have the prerequisite for each course.
- ✓ Failed Compulsory credits must be achieved first (Summer School Applications available in April).

IF YOU ARE GOING TO BE IN GRADE 10 NEXT YEAR

- ✓ Select the Religion Course HRE2O /HRE2OF (Open) (Already selected for you online)
- ✓ Select the Career Studies & Civics Course CHV2O + GLC2O (Open) (Already selected online)
- ✓ Select one English Course ENG2D (Academic) or ENG2P (Applied) or ENG2L (Loc. Developed)
- ✓ Select one Math Course MPM2D (Academic) or MFM2P (Applied) or MAT2L (Loc. Developed)
- ✓ Select one Science Course SNC2D (Academic) or SNC2P (Applied) or SVN3E (Workplace)
- ✓ Select one History Course CHC2D (Academic) or CHC2P (Applied) or CHC2L (Loc. Developed)
- ✓ Select TWO options

IF YOU ARE GOING TO BE IN GRADE 11 NEXT YEAR

- ✓ Select one Religion Course HRE3M /HRE3MF(University/College) or HRE3O (Open)
- ✓ Select one English Course ENG3U (University) or ENG3C (College) or ENG3E (Workplace)
- ✓ Select one Math Course MCR3U (University) or MCF3M (University/College)
- MBF3C (College) or MEL3E (Workplace)
 ✓ Select FIVE options

IF YOU ARE GOING TO BE IN **GRADE 12 NEXT YEAR**

- ✓ Select one Religion Course HRE4M/HRE4MF(Mixed U/C) or HRE4O(Open)
- ✓ Select one English Course ENG4U (University) or ENG4C (College) or ENG4E (Workplace)
- ✓ Select SIX options

(It is essential that that you satisfy the Ontario Secondary School Diploma Requirements and the Entrance Requirements of your Post-Secondary Destination)

Grade 11 & 12 students are strongly recommended to consult with a Student Services counselor and to research post-secondary programs before choosing their courses.
