UNIVERSITY AND COLLEGE INFORMATION SESSIONS

- All students are to report to class and wait to be called to the presentation. Following the presentations, students are to report back to their class.
- Students are expected to stay for the <u>entire session</u> and be respectful to the presenter. No talking, eating or cell phone use during the presentations is allowed.

 Any student who displays inappropriate behaviour will be asked to leave the presentation and <u>will not be able to attend any of the</u> <u>remaining sessions.</u>
